JANUARY 17, 2024  
DOVE CREEK, COLORADO  
BOARD ROOM

President Kimberly Alexander called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. The directors present included Kimberly Alexander, Denny Beanland, Chase Davis, Donella Fury, and Crystal Jarmon.

Guests present included Ty Gray, Roxie Guynes, and Stacy Hankins.

**Business Meeting - Call to Order.**

Mrs. Alexander called for a Roll Call of the Board of Education.

Pledge of allegiance included all in attendance.

**ADDITIONS/APPROVAL OF AGENDA:** Crystal Jarmon moved to approve the agenda as presented. Chase Davis seconded, there was no further discussion, and the motion carried unanimously. After some discussion, Crystal Jarmon moved to amend the agenda to have the District E vacancy moved up right after the approval of the agenda. Donella Fury seconded, there was no further discussion and the motion carried unanimously.

Kimberly Alexander reported that she had one letter of interest from Denny Beanland for the director of District E. Denny was in attendance, and the board asked him to tell them what he currently does for work and what skills he thinks he can bring to the board. Denny replied that he currently works for Dove Creek Road and Bridge. He grew up in the area and attended school here. He has coached and volunteered for many sports. He is a big supporter of Dove Creek students. Crystal Jarmon moved to appoint Denny Beanland as a board director for District E, as discussed. Chase Davis seconded, there was no further discussion, and the motion carried unanimously.

Notary Stacy Hankins gave Denny the oath of office, and he signed the executive session confidentiality statement.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES:** Regular – December 6, 2023 and Special Meeting - December 21, 2023. Chase Davis moved to approve the minutes as presented. Donella Fury seconded, there was no further discussion, and the motion carried unanimously.

**PUBLIC PARTICIPATION:** No public participation.

**REPORTS AND COMMUNICATION:**

**Board and Committee Reports:**

New Elementary School update: Ty reported that the sheeting on 2500 sq ft of the roof is complete. He sat in on interviews all day today with subcontractors. He was impressed with Neenan and how they handled the interviews. Everything is on schedule, and the plan is to be dried in by the end of next week, weather permitting. HVAC has ductwork, sprinkles, and roof drains in place. The admin wing has the studs up, and they are now starting on classrooms. Should be done framing in the next couple of weeks. The date Neenan has for the sign-off on the building is July 19th. He will get another walk-through scheduled for the board soon.

Quarterly Financial Report: Roxie Guynes went over changes made in the revised budget. There were no questions from the board.

BOCES UPDATE: Kimberly handed out a worksheet showing the roles of the executive director for BOCES. Cortez is proceeding with their application to the Commissioner of Education to appeal their denial to leave BOCES. After the Commissioner receives it, she will have 60 days to make a ruling. Ty will be traveling to Denver with other BOCES members to meet with her. If Cortez pulls out of BOCES, the other districts will have to pick up the expense, plus would be competing for the staff. It is not in the district's best interest for Cortez to leave. BOCES business manager has given her notice and will be leaving at the end of June. Per BOCES policy, Kimberly needs a backup BOCES representative. She asked for volunteers. Donella volunteered.

2024-2025 District Calendar: Ty presented the board with the 2024-2025 District Calendar to review. The calendar is basically identical to what it has been for years. School will start on a Wednesday, Christmas break and Thanksgiving break are the same amount of time. Spring break should match up with PCC. Labor Day and President's Day are the other two holidays that we have off. If something happens and the elementary isn't ready, we do have some days the elementary students could use.

### **CONSENT AGENDA (opportunity to consent):**

Crystal Jarmon moved to consent all action items along with the consent agenda, except 10.6, 10.7, & 10.10.1.2, as discussed. Chase Davis seconded, there was no further discussion, and the motion carried unanimously.

Donella Fury moved to approve the consent items as discussed. Crystal Jarmon seconded, there was no further discussion, and the motion carried unanimously.

#### ACTION ITEMS:

**10.6 Open bids for maintenance tractor:** The board received two sealed bids for the maintenance tractor. One from Stouz in the amount of \$70,944.68, and one from Martin's Dove Creek Implement for \$67,051.82. After some discussion, Chase Davis moved to approve the bid from Stouz in the amount of \$70,944.68 as discussed. Crystal Jarmon seconded, there was no further discussion and the motion carried unanimously.

**10.7 Resolution 2024-07 Capital Reserve Expenditure:** Kimberly Alexander moved to approve the capital reserve expenditure for a new maintenance tractor not to exceed \$70,945.00 as presented. Crystal Jarmon seconded, there was no further discussion and the motion carried unanimously.


**10.10.1.2 Michael Fury volunteer middle school girl's basketball coach:** Kimberly Alexander moved to approve Michael Fury as a volunteer middle school girl's basketball coach as presented. Chase Davis seconded; there was no further discussion, and the motion carried unanimously; with Donella Fury abstaining from the vote.


#### PLAN FOR FUTURE MEETINGS



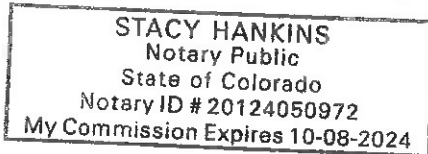

- I. DFPC has issued a building permit and the fire permit. TNC is working on deferred submittal comments with the engineers.

#### ❖ PROCUREMENT

- I. OS Schools has finalized their furniture, fixtures, and equipment packages for the building. The FFE for the building has been ordered.
- II. AG is working with multiple subcontractors to obtain pricing for the make-safe of electrical, plumbing, phone lines, and other utilities prior to demolition of the elementary school in 2024.
- III. After the last day of school for the Spring 2024 semester, movers will come in and move all the furniture and items for the new building to Memorial Hall. The abatement crews will then mobilize and abate the existing school of any asbestos. After abatement is complete, demolition crews will begin dismantling the building. When the new school building is ready, the movers will come back and move everything from Memorial Hall into the new school building.

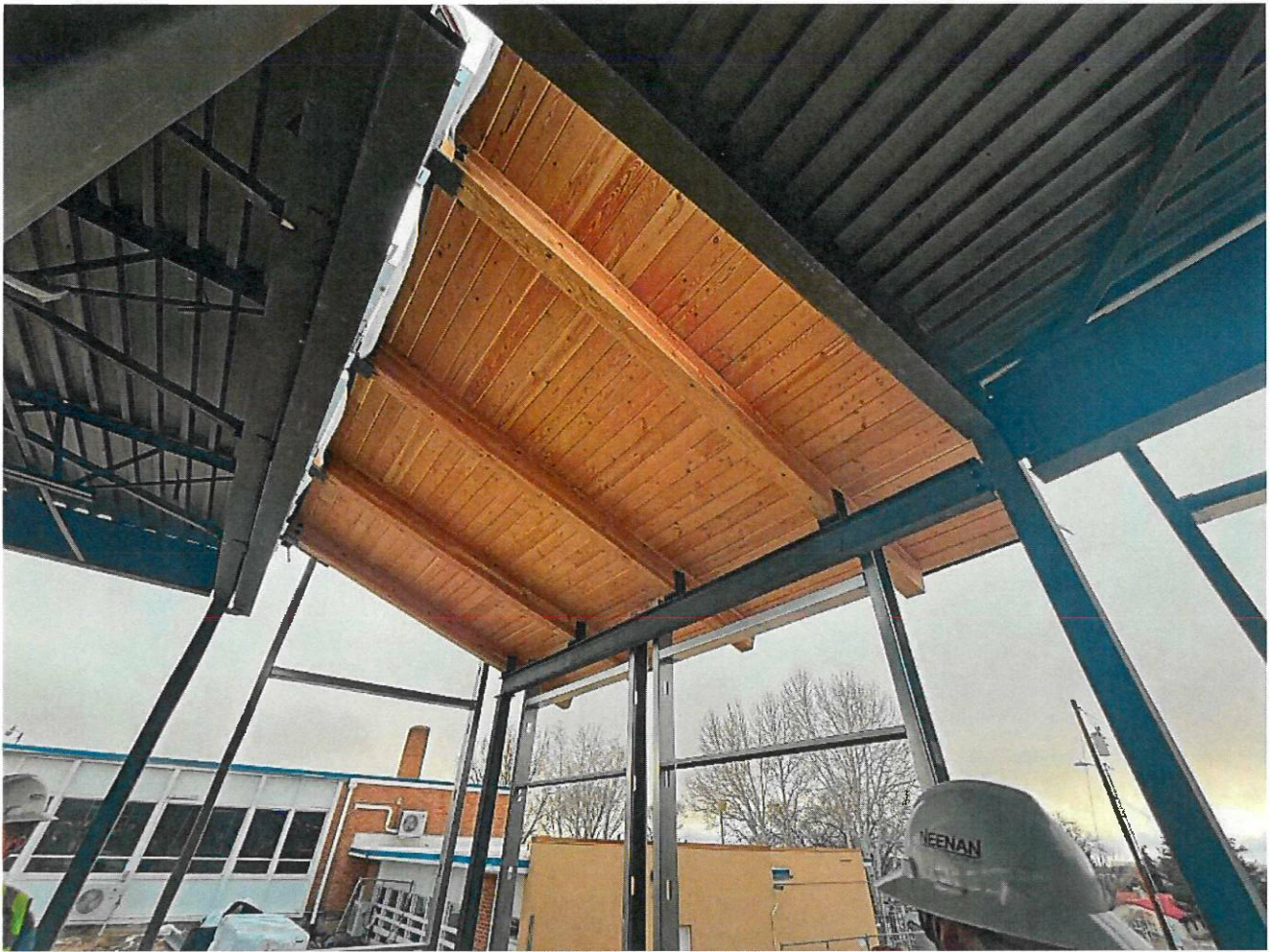

A Resolution of the Board of Education of the DOLORES COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT RE-2J  
Authorizing the Use of a Portion of  
Beginning Fund Balance as Authorized by Colorado Statutes

**WHEREAS**, C.R.S. 22-44-105 states that a budget, duly adopted pursuant to this article, shall not provide for expenditures, interfund transfers, or reserves, in excess of available revenues and beginning fund balance.

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Education may authorize the use of a portion of the beginning fund balance in the budget, stating the amount to be used, the purpose for which the expenditure is needed, and the district's plan to ensure that the use of the beginning fund balance will not lead to an ongoing deficit.


**WHEREAS**, the Board of Education has determined the beginning fund balance in all funds will be used to support only non-recurring expenditures and this action will not lead to an on-going deficit and is the most fiscally responsible approach for the District

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:**

In accordance with C.R.S. 22-44-105, the Board of Education authorizes the use of a portion of the fiscal year 2023-2024 Beginning Fund Balance for the following funds:

- \*CAPITAL PROJECTS FUND, in the amount \$56,000 to purchase vehicles.
- \* BOND REDEMPTION FUND, in the amount \$11,125 to pay semi-annual bond payment.
- \* BUILDING FUND, in the amount \$11,224,834 for new construction project.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, the use of this portion of the beginning fund balance for the purposes set forth above will not lead to an ongoing deficit.



## Board Organizational Meeting

Within 15 days after the school district receives the official abstract of votes, the Board shall meet in an organizational session at a regular or special meeting for the purpose of selecting officers.

The incumbent president of the Board shall preside until a successor is elected, whereupon the successor will assume the chair.

Following the swearing in of the newly-elected Board member or members, the following officers, in order, shall be elected or appointed: president, vice president, secretary and treasurer.

Nominations for president and vice president shall be made from the floor and voting shall be by roll call or secret ballot. Should no nominee receive a majority vote of Board members, the election shall be declared null and void, further nominations may be made and the roll call or secret ballot vote shall be retaken.

The president and vice president shall serve two-year terms and shall hold office until their successors are elected.

The Board shall then appoint a secretary and treasurer who may or may not be members of the Board. The secretary and treasurer shall hold their offices for terms at the pleasure of the Board.

Following election and appointment of the officers, the Board shall appoint the staff member who will fill the office of secretary to the Board.

Then such other items of business shall be considered by the Board as are scheduled on the agenda.

### Officer resignation

Should one or more officers of the Board resign, the Board shall select another member or members to fill the vacant office or offices as provided by law, using the procedures described above. A newly selected officer shall assume the duties immediately upon selection. Inasmuch as the selection of a new officer on a four-officer, ~~five~~seven-member board frequently requires a shifting of officers it shall be permissible for a member to be nominated for another office without resigning the current office. Upon acceptance of the nomination and election to the new office, the former office shall be declared vacant and another member elected to fill that position.

## State Program Assessments

The district shall participate in statewide performance assessment programs and in the Colorado Student Assessment Program if schools, classes or students from the district are selected for a statewide sample and when students within a grade or grades are being assessed.

Students who have participated in the English Language Proficiency Program pursuant to state law for more than three years shall be ineligible to take state assessments in a language other than English.

Pursuant to state law, statewide assessments will be administered during the period between the second Monday in March through the third Monday in April each year.

The Colorado Department of Education is required to provide diagnostic academic growth information for each student enrolled in the district and for each public school in the district based on the state assessment results for the preceding school years. This information shall be included in each student's individual student record. Appropriate school personnel, including those who work directly with the student, shall have access to the student's statewide assessment results and longitudinal academic growth information and shall explain that information to the student's parent/guardian.

Except for the college entrance exam, results of the assessment shall be included on each student's final report card for that school year and made part of the student's permanent academic record. Results of the college entrance exam shall be included on each student's transcript. However, if a student retakes the exam at a later time at the student's expense, the student may request that the later results be placed on the transcript in place of the earlier results.
